### **CAMPAIGN IS NOW CLOSED**

Letters are key in battling isolation in prison, they are one of the few glimmers of hope a person in jail can have. It is especially important since, as we learned recently, Vladimir's jailers stopped allowing letters to come through — but for all we know, our letters have passed censorship and have been delivered.
